Individuals to teach part-time at the university level. Ph.D. or master's degree required, experience preferred. Individuals are expected to hold employment at one other institution at a minimum. In addition to class instruction, applicants will be required to spend significant time preparing courses, grading papers, advising students, and providing office hours with no additional compensation. No subsidized health care or other benefits are offered. No seniority or any other form of job security will be guaranteed. Part-time lecturers will have no protections of academic freedom and will not participate in department meetings. Appointment will be on a semester-by-semester basis. If hired, it will be necessary to reapply at least twice a year. Expect confusion and delay with pay checks and any pay raises. Apply now!
