

## **Best Practices For NTT Faculty at Selected Rutgers Departments**

### **Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy**

#### **1. Faculty Governance**

Full-time non-tenure track faculty of the Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy vote for and run as candidates for the school-wide steering committee, faculty council, and chair of the school's Congress. As members of the Bloustein faculty council, they can vote on curriculum and admissions and can serve as members of the graduate faculty. NTT faculty who are full-time can also serve on formal and ad hoc committees within the school e.g. curriculum committee, quality of life committee, and the committee to revise the undergraduate major. They can also represent the school in the university senate and the New Brunswick Faculty Council. NTT faculty, however, may not vote on faculty personnel issues.

#### **2. FASIP**

The Bloustein School makes the FASIP merit program available to full-time non-tenure track faculty of the school. NTT faculty are included in the usual notice provisions to apply for the merit increases provided to the school's entire full-time faculty. NTT faculty have regularly received increases under this program. The NTT faculty, however, are not eligible to be members of the faculty committee which makes award recommendations to the dean.

### **School of Social Work**

#### **1. Department Meetings**

Fulltime NTT Faculty are invited to faculty meetings, sit in on colloquiums where potential faculty members present as part of their interview process, and receive all e-mail notices/general mail as a 'real' faculty member.

### **Genetics Department**

#### **1. FASIP**

Genetics department makes the merit program available to Research faculty. There is a separate committee made up of Research faculty to review their FASIP applications.

#### **2. Department Meetings**

Research Faculty in the Genetics department attend faculty meetings have voting rights for new hires and departmental decisions but not for tenure decisions.

## **Entomology Department**

### **1. Department Meetings**

Fulltime NTT faculty in the entomology department are allowed to attend departmental meetings and take part in all departmental activities.

### **2. Graduate Students**

Faculty serve on graduate student committees and have graduate and teaching assistants.

## **School of Law in Camden**

### **1. Departmental Meetings**

Fulltime NTT faculty at the School of Law in Camden attend departmental meeting and can vote on all departmental matters except for hiring decisions and promotion and tenure decisions.

### **2. Departmental Committees**

Fulltime NTT faculty can serve on departmental wide committees with the exception of FASIP

### **3. FASIP**

Fulltime NTT faculty receive money from the FASIP Pool but do not serve on the committee.

### **4. Professional Development**

Fulltime NTT faculty receive funding to attend and speak at professional conferences.

## **Department of Chemistry and Chemical Biology**

### **1. Departmental Meetings**

Fulltime NTT faculty attend faculty meetings, but do not have a vote on departmental decisions.

### **2. Federal Funding**

Fulltime NTT faculty are permitted to apply for their own federal funding to support their research.

### **3. Parking**

Fulltime NTT faculty have access to the gated parking lot in the Chemistry Department

## **History Department and African American and American Studies Department**

### **1. Departmental Meetings**

Fulltime NTT Faculty attend faculty meetings and social functions.

## **Rutgers University Libraries**

### **1. FASIP Awards**

Fulltime NTT librarians are included in FASIP awards

### **2. Departmental Committees**

Fulltime NTT librarians serve on and chair department committees, excepts those required by bylaws to be composed of tenured faculty.

### **3. Faculty Governance**

After two years of serve fulltime NTT librarians are able to vote on matters of faculty governance.

### **4. Professional Development**

Fulltime NTT librarians are given funding and are encouraged to attend professional meetings.

## **Biotech Center for Agriculture & the Environment**

### **1. FASIP**

Fulltime NTT receive raises as part of FASIP

## **Rutgers Business School**

### **2. Department Committees**

Fulltime NTT Faculty members serve on a variety of committees including Teaching Innovations and Methods, and Distance Learning.

### **3. Department Meetings**

Fulltime NTT Faculty members attend all faculty meetings including an annual retreat.
